12. Course contents:

The material comprises the architecture on Bulgarian lands from 5^{th} c. B.C. to the middle the 20^{th} c. It includes:

- General information about the appearance and development of different architectural types;
- Architectural analysis of the same;
- Multimedia presentation of suitable examples;
- Data about the most important Bulgarian and visiting architects during the

Renaissance and Post-liberation period;

- Acquainting with the work of the first generations Bulgarian architects.

- 14. **Planned learning activities and teaching methods**: lectures and multimedia presentations 5 hours per week, 6 weeks delivering part of the lectures in an authentic architectural environment in the towns Devnya, Targoviste, Kotel and the villages Medven, Ichera, Katuniste, Zheravna;
 - a test on 2/3 of the material and an essay
- 15. Assessment methods and criteria The final grade consists of two parts a continuous assessment grade and an exam grade. The continuous assessment grade is formed on the basis of presence during lectures, the grade from the test and the essay (an average grade). The exam is a written one, under the form of a test. The continuous assessment test and the exam test consist of open and closed questions. A correct answer or a correct drawing to the open graphic questions brings a bonus of 0.50 added to the grade. The final grade is an average from the continuous assessment grade and the exam grade. The tests are stored for a year thus allowing everybody to look at their work and find information about the motives for the respective grade.
