- 10. Mode of delivery: face-to-face
- 11. **Prerequisites and co-requisites**: To do the course students need to have passed successfully all the compulsory courses in architecture and urban planning, including the first pre-diploma project.
- 12. Course contents:
- Mastering the methodology for making Detailed Site Development Plans (DSDP) of the settlements;
- Analyzing the condition of the given settlement territory, including visiting the place, formulating the goal and the objectives of DSDP;
- Studying the requirements for DSDP, according to the Law on Territory Planning and Regulation 8
- Making the planned and spatial structure of the territory;
- Functional zoning of the territory;
- Defining the social infrastructure and the green system;
- Making the street network and the engineering and technical infrastructure;
- Developing a plan for building up, for the urban zones and indexes;

The seminars include:

Making DSDP of a residential, manufacturing and servicing territory in a 1:2000 (1:1 00) scale in drafts and models;
