14. Planned learning activities and teaching methods:

Lecture course –30 hours per semester

- presenting a project assignment with 3 examples with analyses
- Project assignment in a scale M 1:200 in conceptual stage 60 hours per 15 weeks
- contact hours direct and distance (by internet)

Students' individual work, in-class and out-of-class work is encouraged. It is required students to use tracing paper and a pencil in the pre-project phase, to be corrected by the lecturer with a pencil on the tracing paper and then transferred on CAD systems. Students are also encouraged to study scale models made of cardboard and plastics.

15. Assessment methods and criteria: The project assessment is done in front of a commission of lecturers delivering the course with the presence of the students from

the course. It is a written exam with the same for all the students questions and practical work with a change in the sub-groups in order to be prevented copying from each other. The time limit is 60-90 minutes.
