- 9. **Learning outcomes of the course unit**: to initiate students in the problems of management of investments; to give students knowledge and skills to choose the proper investment goals, to evaluate and choose the best options for investment by the use of investment projects; to master the methods for planning, implementation and control of investment projects.

Special attention is paid to the possibility for investment in a perspective branch by suggesting a scheme for analysis of competition (resistance) based on diagnose of motive powers in the branch, as well as analyzing and minimizing the risk when investing in real assets.
