The discipline deals with the functions of management and the possible structural decisions in their distribution among the managerial organs, as well as with the problems of the organizational regulations and delegation of powers as a means of solving the structural and functional problems, the basic problems of the technology of management, such as the decision-making in the process of management, management methods and the leadership style used by the modern managers.
