9. Objectives of the course: The main aim of the course Fashion Project and Collage is to foster students' inspiration for creative work and capacity for analytical and ingenious creative thinking. The discipline develops the knowledge and skills for designing fashion collections, obtained in the Bachelor's programme, while encouraging creative approaches to experimenting and authorship.
10. Type of teaching: face-to-face
11. Prerequisites: Students must have basic knowledge about fashion design from the Bachelor's programme.
12. Course content: Introduction to the upcoming fashion trends. Design collections of clothing and accessories in several fashion trends with suggestions for fabrics and colour schemes. Arrangement and presentation. Use of collage as an expression.
