9. Learning outcomes of the course unit: The course "Fundamentals of Law" aims to give students basic knowledge of contemporary law and its relationship with other regulatory systems. Law is seen as a specific social phenomenon, for the study of which there are different approaches. The nature of the law is considered from the viewpoint of normativeness as well as of modern philosophical- sociological concept of law.

12. Course contents: The main purpose of this course is to give students skills in using modern legislative decisions in their future work as practitioners.
