9. Learning outcomes of the course unit: acquisition of knowledge in the field of international public law
10. Mode of delivery: face-to-face.
11. Prerequisites and co-requisites: General questions of international law are studied, taking into account knowledge about the fundamental problems of the general theory of law, history and theory of state and law, constitutional law.
12. Course contents (annotation): The system of the course covers: complex legal issues in the international cooperation between subjects of international law; principles and norms of legal regulation of international relations; nature, status and functions of international organizations, legal foundations of international security; the regime of international spaces and territories, peaceful means of settling international disputes, and others.

14. Planned learning activities and teaching methods: lectures, seminars, thesis (course work).
15. Assessment methods and criteria: Written examination - according to a schedule. At the written exam, each student receives six questions and the answer to each of the questions yields one point. For example, if they answer three questions the rating is Satisfactory (3). Responses should be complete, clear and precise and cover all the essential elements of the question. For a reply to only one or two questions, the assessment is Poor (2) and the student takes the exam again at the supplementary examination or the liquidation session, for which the same rules apply . Assessment of learning : assessment of students at the semester examination can be increased if they have taken active part during the semester seminars and showed good results in the thesis (course work), included as independent work within the curriculum. Within the day of the exam, students can check their omissions in the written work.
