Learning outcomes of the course unit knowledge, skills and competences acquired The purpose of the course "Financial Statements and Financial Analysis in Tourism" is to give students knowledge in the preparation and use of financial statements of companies engaged in tourism services. Skills to perform financial analysis using information from financial statements.
- 10. Mode of delivery: face-to-face.
- 11. Prerequisites and co-requisites: Students should have a basic knowledge of accounting taught at undergraduate level accounting courses.
- 12. Course contents: Content and Technology of preparation of the financial statements. Opportunities and tools for financial analysis of balance sheet, income statement and other parts of the financial statements are considered.

- 14. Planned learning activities and teaching methods:

The teaching in the course includes lectures presented by media, seminars, work meetings; analysis of financial statement.

15. Assessment methods and criteria:

Test includes about 20 questions, closed and open. Questions earn maximum points with different weights from 2 to 6 points according to the difficulty of the questions. In partially correct answer to a question put less points than the maximum possible. The sum of the points of the test is determined at a percentage of the maximum number of points on the test. Estimates were for test determined :50% - 55% - average 3, 56% - 65% Good 4, 66% - 80% - very good 5, 80-100% - Excellent 6.
