Acquiring complex knowledge and developing an adequate attitude for project organization and management given the processes and tendencies in the development in the Republic of Bulgaria in the conditions of the EU accession and membership.

Course contents: The course studies the problems of the nature and content of the project (program) organization and of project management given the traditional organizational forms, specific to the linear-functional management. It surveys the objective conditions and premises that have determined the arising of project management, as well as its nature, as an attempt to combine the advantages of management by objectives, on the one hand, and program management on the other. In a sequence, the course studies the organizational forms which are adequate to the different types of project organization and are known in the literature and practice as program-goal structures. The course surveys the latest tendencies in the use of project management in relationship to the formation and application of various EU financial instruments.
