Learning outcomes of the course unit: As a result of the course postgraduates will be able to: understand the basic concepts related to risks; understand the relationship between risks, assumptions and problems; identify risks through various techniques for collecting information; analyze potential risks and determine on which of them to focus; plan for risk response using different alternatives and options; monitor known risks and periodically evaluate the project to identify new risks.

11. Prerequisites and co-requisites: postgraduates are required to have basic knowledge of project management.

Course contents: The actuality of the course is related to the fact that project management is a projective process which seeks to eliminate potential problems before they occur, thus increasing the likelihood of successful project implementation. The highlights of the course are: an overview and definition of risk; concepts - risks, assumptions, problems; identifying risks; risk categories; risk analysis; risk response; risk control.
