9. Learning outcomes of the course unit – The proposed course is taught in the third semester of the Master's degree program. It aims to familiarize postgraduates with multimedia computer systems, and in particular with different multimedia formats - image, audio, video. Postgraduates can carry out video editing using the editor Adobe Premiere Pro 1,5 - CS4 by means of the acquired practical knowledge during the course. Practical classes are held in the form of laboratory work aimed at building specific practical skills for working with the widely spread video editor Adobe Premiere Pro 1,5 - CS4. Multimedia video lessons in Russian and English, illustrating how the editor works, are used in studying the various technology options.

12. Course contents: Adobe Premiere – Workspace, main work panes. Working with transitions. Animation clips. Transparencies. Effects. Text editing. Sound editing. Setup and generation of a final video file. Digital video streaming.
