- 9. Learning outcomes of the course unit: The course will help students in their future work as professionals in public administration or non-governmental organizations. Crime and antisocial behavior are a relatively independent subject of prevention and control in the implementation of which students can realize themselves professionally. The new ideas concerning the development of the criminal justice system in our country contemplate the introduction of new institutions such as probation, mediation etc., which can usefully be applied to children, too. This will allow more VFU graduates to implement themselves more confidently in a new and specific to them activity.

- 11. Prerequisites and co-requisites: Assimilation of the material requires prior knowledge acquired in the courses: Criminal Law general and special part, Forensic Science general part and Forensic Science types of crimes etc..
- 12. Course contents: The scientific discipline is to expand knowledge about: 1) juvenile delinquency and antisocial behavior of children and related contemporary changes, characteristics and trends in the terms of crime globalization; 2) marginalization of children and related criminal behavior and victimization; 3) general and specific factors determining crime and antisocial behavior as a global process; 4) legal regime of responsibility of minor and juvenile offenders: procedures for handling misdemeanors a system of disciplinary measures, protection of children's rights through the participation of public defenders; appeal and its procedure; judicial control; accommodation in youth custody centres; procedure for accommodation to youth custody centres; 5) juvenile criminal law system and procedures for handling cases against juveniles (the Penal Code and the Criminal Procedure Code) 6) the system of prevention and control over delinquency of juveniles and minors under the Law to Combat Delinquency of Juveniles and Minors and the Penal Code.
