9. Learning outcomes of the course unit: Through the course students acquire skills in working on certain national or local programmes to combat crime, including developing programmes and strategies appropriate for this purpose. Learning a system of knowledge about the prevention and control over crime is in order to acquire practical skills in developing management documents: strategies, programmes, plans, etc.
10. Mode of delivery: face-to-face
11. Prerequisites and co-requisites: Learning the material requires that students have prior knowledge as a result of completing the courses in Criminal Law-general and specialized part, Criminology-general part, as well as Criminology-types of crime, Juvenile Delinquency, Organized Crime, etc.
12. Course contents: The course "Organization of Crime Prevention" is fundamental to learning the theory of prevention and the practical activity relating to the implementation of the prevention and control over crime. The main problems are focused on two basic groups: first, the theory of prevention, comprising: a) general social and special criminological prevention (individual, group, general), principles of preventive policy and more; b) control over crime and modern strategies based on the principle of subsidiarity of law, policy of decriminalization and the resulting depenalization.
