- 9. Learning outcomes of the course unit: The course gives students deep special knowledge and builds a system of qualified legal skills in the field of constitutional law. Special attention is paid to the acquisition of deep knowledge about the doctrine of constitution, basic constitutional principles, freedoms of citizens and the system of state bodies. Students acquire skills to use modern legislative solutions in their future work as practising specialists; to use the methods of empiric study for deeper penetration into the complex legal cases, which are a part of the dynamic changes of the legal regulatory activities.

- 12. Course unit contents: A considerable place is given to the questions of modern constitutionalism and parliamentary activity. A central place in the lecture course is given to state institutions, too. Through tracing the history of modern development of the three powers, of the institution of the Head of State, of the specialized body of constitutional control the Constitutional Court and of the local self-government, it is outlined the Bulgarian appurtenance to the European tradition, the general and the specific in constitutional solutions are drawn. The course includes mainly the Bulgarian newest development in historical and comparative plan, as well as the study of the Constitution and constitutional bases of the legal status of the person.
