9. Learning outcomes of the course unit: The aim of the discipline "Social Security Law" is to equip the students with the necessary theoretical knowledge in the field of security law and welfare rights which will enable them to solve independently specific security and legal issues, arising in public practice. An important result of this discipline is students to acquire skills for independent research in the field of security law and the welfare rights.

10. Mode of delivery: face-to-face

11. Prerequisites and co-requisites: The discipline "Social Security Law" has as its subject of study the existing objective social security law and the welfare rights. In this course the students, majoring in Law at the Faculty of Law receive the necessary knowledge related to the basic principles, concepts and institutions of the social security law and the welfare rights.

The importance of this discipline is determined by the particularly important role of the material security of citizens when specified and legally settled in legislation secured social risks occur or when citizens experience material difficulty which they cannot overcome on their own or with their relatives.

12. Course contents: The course introduces the basic principles, concepts and institutions of social security law and the welfare rights.

14. Planned learning activities and teaching methods: The discipline is taught through lecture presentation of the main issues of the subject matter as for the different topics scheduled seminars are planned. Individual contact hours are planned for those who wish. At the end of the training course, a discussion with representatives from the practice is planned.

15. Assessment methods and criteria: Two tests on questions of the general and specific part of the social security law are scheduled. At the end of the lecture course the students have to submit coursework on a chosen topic from the topic list to sit for the semester exam. The final form of assessment is oral examination. The final mark is based on the results of the oral examination and coursework (1/2 of the mark), as well as the average mark of the tests (1/2 of the mark)

16. Language of instruction: Bulgarian.

17. Work placement: Visits to Varna District Court, and attendance at sittings of the court which deal with social security disputes. Visit to Social Security Regional Office - Varna and Regional Health Insurance Fund – Varna and familiarizing with the practical activities for implementation of public and health insurance.
