9. Learning outcomes of the course unit: The objective of the course "Labour Law" is, while doing it, students to acquire the necessary theoretical knowledge in the field of labour law, which can give them the opportunity to solve by themselves specific problems arising in public practice. An important result of this training course will also be the formation in students of habits of independent research work in the field of labour law.
10. Mode of delivery: face-to-face
11. Prerequisites and co-requisites: The course "Labour Law" has as its subject the current study of labour law as a branch in the system of objective law of the Republic of Bulgaria. In this course, law students at the Faculty of Law acquire the necessary knowledge related to the basic principles, concepts and institutions of labour law. The importance of this course is determined by the position which wage labour occupies in modern society and the vital importance of labour relations arising from participation in the labour process.
12. Course contents: It presents the basic principles, concepts and institutions of labour law.

14. Planned learning activities and teaching methods: The course is taught through lecture presentation of the main points of the curriculum; seminars are planned and provided on certain topics. Individual contact hours are also planned for those students who want. At the end of the study course a discussion with representatives from the practice is planned.

15. Assessment methods and criteria: Students are supposed to do two tests on two questions respectively of the individual and collective labour law. At the end of the course students should submit a course assignment on a chosen by them topic from the synopsis for doing the semester examination. The final form of assessment is an oral examination. The final grade will be formed by the results of the oral examination and the course assignment (half of the assessment), and the rounded average grade of the tests (half of the assessment).

17. Work placement: Visits to the District Court - Varna and presence at court hearings which deal with disputes on labour disputes at first and second instance.
