- 9. Learning outcomes of the course unit: The objective of the course is to give students new knowledge about theoretical conceptions, basic practical skills in planning, organizing and preparing activities for elimination of consequences of emergencies in atomic, hydroelectric and thermoelectric power stations and industrial enterprises on the territory of the country (the Republic of Bulgaria). Students to learn the basics of management of formations and resources during disasters and major industrial accidents.
- 10. Mode of delivery: face-to-face
- 11. Prerequisites and co-requisites: The course is a summarizing one for the whole training of students of the specialization 'Protection from Emergencies and Disasters'. It is mutually related to and based on the following courses: Theory of Risk and Safety; Constitutional Law, Fire Development and Extinguishment; Emergency and Rescue Techniques and Tactics; Legal Regime in Times of Disasters, Accidents and Catastrophes; State Power and State Administration.
- 12. Course contents: The course includes issues, *first* are those connected with the system for crises management –authorities and centres for crises management. The *second group of issues* discusses the problems connected with prognosticating, planning and training as well as the control of activities on the preparation of population for actions during crises. The *third group* of questions discusses the activities connected with the protection of population during crises as well as traditional and alternative approaches to searching reliable methods and means of management of forces and resources during mastering critical situations, logistic provision of the participants in mastering crises.
