Learning outcomes of the course unit: students to acquire in-depth, basic theoretical knowledge of the organization and main activities on protection of classified information as well as of the underlying concepts. Students should be able to use the acquired knowledge when working in the state and non-state law enforcement system aimed at detecting, preventing and suppressing unauthorized access to classified information.
10. Mode of delivery: face-to-face.
11. Prerequisites and co-requisites: Students are expected to have knowledge and use the basic conceptual apparatus of courses done in previous years of study.
