- 12. Course unit contents: The subject encompasses subject matter, connected with the international legal regime of the Black Sea; the course deals with the marine spaces, the international cooperation on the issues, connected with the shipping and the Black Sea economic cooperation.

- 14. Planned learning activities and teaching methods: Lectures.
- 15. Assessment methods and criteria: Written examination according to a schedule. At the written semester exam, each student is given six questions, as a correct answer to each of these questions receives one grade unit. For example, answering three questions the student gets the grade: Fair (3). Answers need to be complete, clear and explicit and cover all the essential elements of the questions given. The grade is Poor (2) for answers to only one or two questions and the student takes the exam again at a supplementary examination session, for which these same rules apply, as well as for the liquidation session. The student's semester grade can be increased if he/she has participated actively in semester classes. On the day of the exam students can check the shortcomings in their written exam papers.
