- 9. Learning outcomes of the course unit: The curriculum is designed for Law students of the specialized module in Maritime Law. Marine insurance launches the insurance sector worldwide, retaining, at the same time, its specificity being significantly different in organizational and legal content from other types and forms of insurance.
