- 9. Learning outcomes of the course unit: The course aims at acquiring basic knowledge and practical skills about the organization, tactics and methodology of investigation. Knowledge in Forensic Science finds application in the pre-trial and forensic investigation. For that reason the course is part of the professional training of the experts.
- 10. Mode of delivery: face-to-face
- 11. Prerequisites and co-requisites: Students need to have knowledge acquired from the courses in Criminal Procedure Law and Criminal Law general and special parts.
- 12. Course contents: Forensic Science is a criminal law science whose basic task is in accordance with its subject to facilitate scientifically the crimes to be revealed, the guilty people to be exposed and the law to be applied correctly. This is the reason the course in Forensic Science to be studied in the major Forensic Expertise. The subject of the course are topics connected with the study of crimes of criminally important point of view (way of study, mechanism, etc.), its substantive reflection (types of marks and its information properties, etc.) and the information cognitive process when investigating identification, version building, investigation activities and the methodology of investigating different types of crimes.

- 14. Planned learning activities and teaching methods: lecture, seminars and contact hours. The defense of the project assignment at the end of the seminars is a necessary condition for sitting the exam at the regular examination session. The project assignment includes the results from the practical work of the students (taking fingerprints, finding comparative samples, making plaster casts, making record of evidence, etc.), enriched by the independent work of the students and the contact hours with the lecturer.
- 15. Assessment methods: written exam. At the written exams the test form is the preferred one, but with free answers to the questions. Six questions are given, each of which can comprise one topic or several topics from the synopsis. An excellent grade is given for six correct thorough responses; a very good grade is given for five correct thorough responses, etc. The answers require not only knowledge but also thinking on the corresponding topics.
