9. Learning outcomes of the course unit: The main objective of the course is the students to cultivate attitude for using forensic psychiatric expertise when there are certain prerequisites; to cultivate attitude for working in a team with specialists from the field of the forensic psychiatric expertise; to acquire knowledge and skills referring to the qualitative appointing of forensic psychiatric expertise and the correct interpretation from their conclusions; to require experts to follow the normative requirements and ethical standards when carrying out forensic psychiatric expertise.
10. Mode of delivery: face-to-face
11. Prerequisites and co-requisites: In order to understand and master the subject it is necessary students to have preliminary knowledge of criminal and civil law, the normative regulation of the forensic expertise; knowledge of forensic science, psychopathology, and clinical psychiatry, knowledge about the psychological processes disorders, intellectual disorders and personality disorders; knowledge of the norms for medical duress.
12. Course contents: From ancient times to present days jurisdiction has used knowledge from the experts to solve legal cases. Psychiatric science is not an exception in its close relationship with jurisdiction in the field of the forensic psychiatry and its possibilities. When the professionals from the field of law are familiar with the nature and application of forensic psychiatry, they will be able to analyze more carefully the legal cases and to offer more adequate solutions to them. Forensic psychiatry is a scientific and practical subject in the interdisciplinary field between law and psychiatry which uses medical (psychiatric) methods and means to assess the possible psychic disorders and psychic capacity of the individuals in an expert way when they are related with problems from the different fields of law – criminal and civil. Forensic psychiatry is a medical scientific and practical subject which deals with identification, analysis, expertise, mastering and overcoming social dangerous tendencies in the behavior of mentally diseased by risk assessment and applying medical duress.
